





IMPACT TO THE COMMUNITY


So many are dependent on the grid, and evacuation forces you to leave your home and may disable or challenge infrastructure (i.e. phone lines and internet access); impacts our rural population to a high degree

SOLUTIONS

Groundless internet (Starlink), satellite phones, solar powered hand crank radios – tech that is mobile; considering new uses for social media as a news source

VOLCANIC ERUPTION

AIR QUALITY

--- CONCERNS

Noxious gases including sulphur dioxide and hydrogen sulfide may impact human health and surrounding wildlife, agriculture and physical infrastructure

- SOLUTIONS

Access to gas masks, education around gas masks, monitoring and alerting communities about air quality & risks, safely evacuating those with respiratory conditions, pop-up tents to provide respiratory health assessment & care

HURRICANE SAFETY & SECURITY

CONCERNS

Safe shelter for people and animals, clean up and clearing of debris following the disaster, recovering from direct damage to buildings and structures

- SOLUTIONS

Education on hurricane safety preparedness, support for local groups in the community to self-organize to clear roadways (i.e. chainsaw support & debris removal), chainsaw training, need for an emergency shelter in Puna Makai

CONCERNS


Providing a space for the community to access backup and emergency energy (i.e. food and medication storage, access to wifi and charging)

- SOLUTIONS

Creating hubs that are able to provide energy—including charging access points, wifi access points, refrigeration, etc. for community use when these resources are unavailable to them; education on energy preparedness & response

CONCERNS


Ensuring community members have food access during disasters and continuously building a robust local food system

SOLUTIONS

Resilience-building programs to teach individuals self-sufficiency in terms of home and community gardening, supporting access to food in the local environment (farmers, harvesting, groceries)


Ensuring adequate access to supplies and resources for community members for general wellbeing and medical care

CURRENT OFFERINGS RESOURCES

- Starlink groundless wifi: installed in Fall 2022, made possible through microgrant funding with Vibrant Hawaii at our store, Hale Aloha
- Bulletin Board at Hale Aloha: Sharing resources and information with our local community
- Red Road Resource Fair with SPACE: connecting with other local organizations and the public
- Community Emergency Response skills survey: capturing skills within our organization to know who may be able and available to assist in disasters



CURRENT OFFERINGS EDUCATION

- Grow Resilience class series: made possible through Vibrant Hawaii microgrant funding
- Garden Club: weekly immersive mālama 'āina opportunity for the public
- Community Arts Program: 25+ weekly classes offered at sliding scale or free/donation-based
- Kūkulu Kumuhana o Puna Summer Youth Groups: supporting place-based education and skill development with local partners and educators
- Mental Health First Aid training: several members of our team have participated and we continue to share this opportunity as new dates arise
